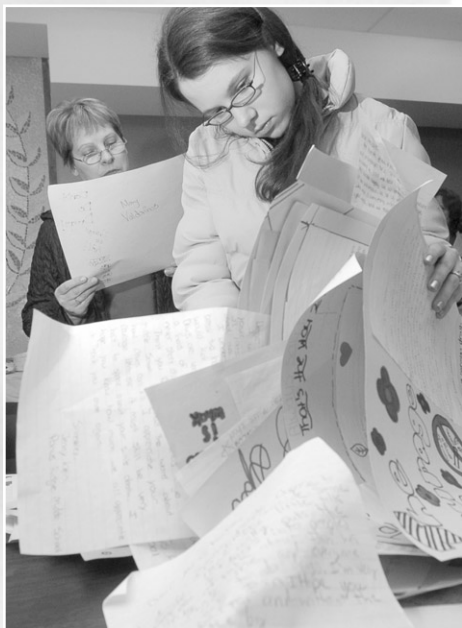

The organization has been approved by the Internal Revenue Service for tax deductible status under Section 501 (c)(3).

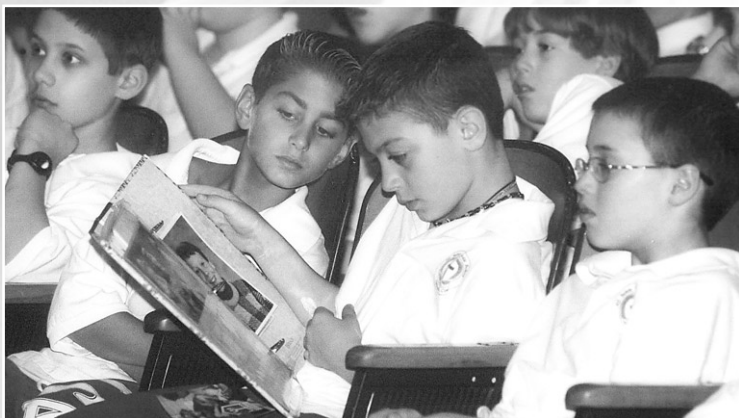
