Sunny's Story is narrated through the eyes, ears and mind of Sunny, the family beagle, and tells of the ups and downs of his life with his young master, from the moment they met at an animal shelter to Sunny's anguished yelps watching his best friend succumb to drugs. **"If only our pet could talk – could warn us we'd lose our son to drugs."**

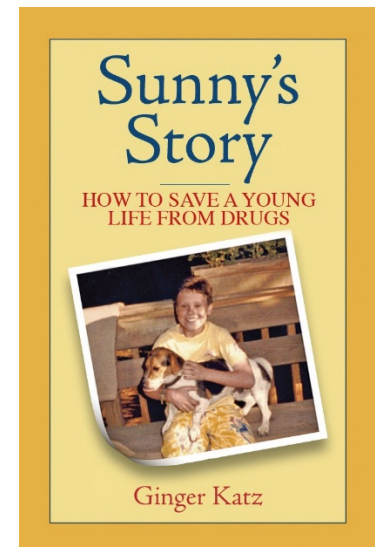
